Scholarships are available through the Harold R. Alexander Memorial Orange Foundation Scholarship for eligible applicants for the year 2015.

The scholarship program was set up in 1998 to benefit the members of the men's and ladies lodges, their children and/or grandchildren. Included are the children and/or grandchildren of deceased members who were in good standing at the time of their death. The campaign runs from January 7, 2015 to June 10, 2015.

Applicants must be a full-time college or university student who has completed or is completing his/her first or freshman year. You may request an application at anytime and the application should be returned on or before June 10, 2015.

The program is a competitive program with a limited number of awards granted to those who meet the necessary criteria, show academic promise and financial need, and properly complete the application. As a courtesy, all applicants will be notified by mail prior to July 25, 2015, as to whether or not a scholarship will be awarded to them.

All applications for scholarships must be on the forms provided by the Orange Foundation Scholarship Committee, there will be no exceptions.

We are also selling Union Flag badges at £2 each.

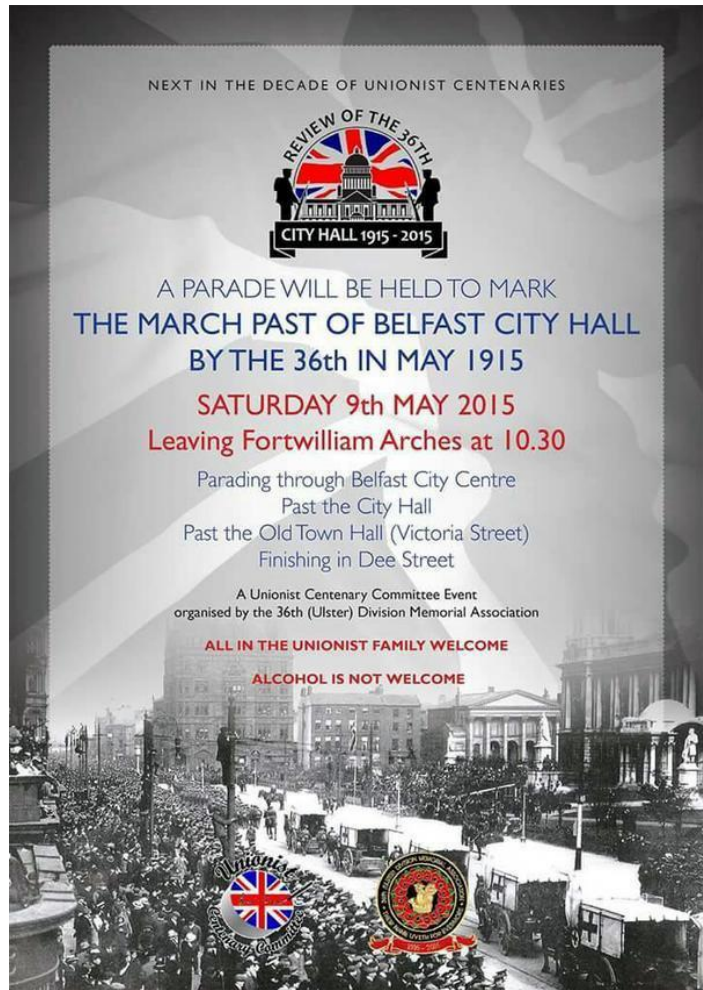

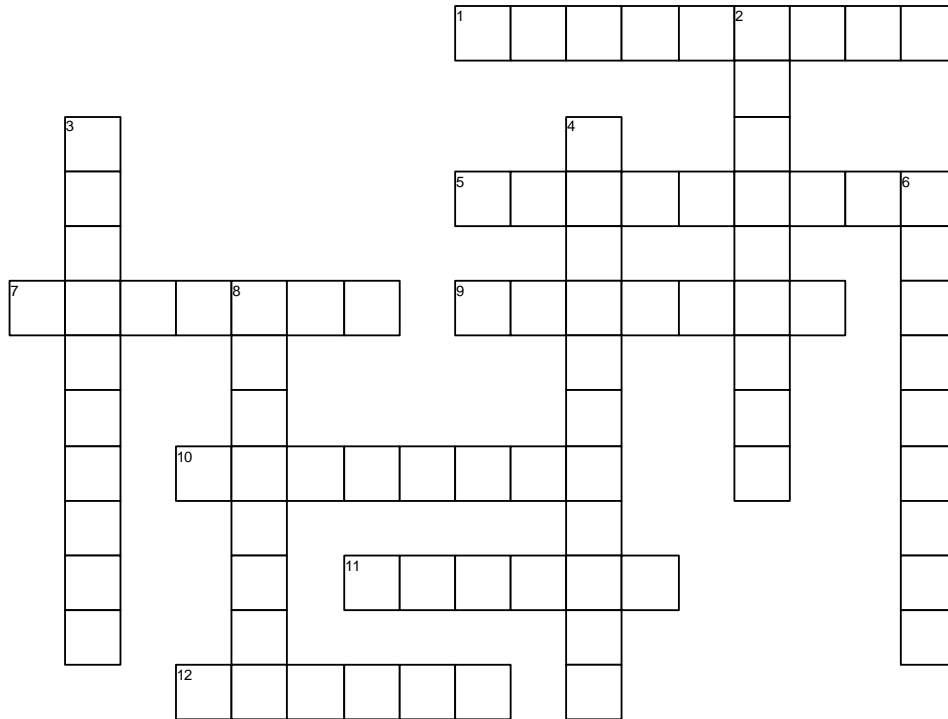
