

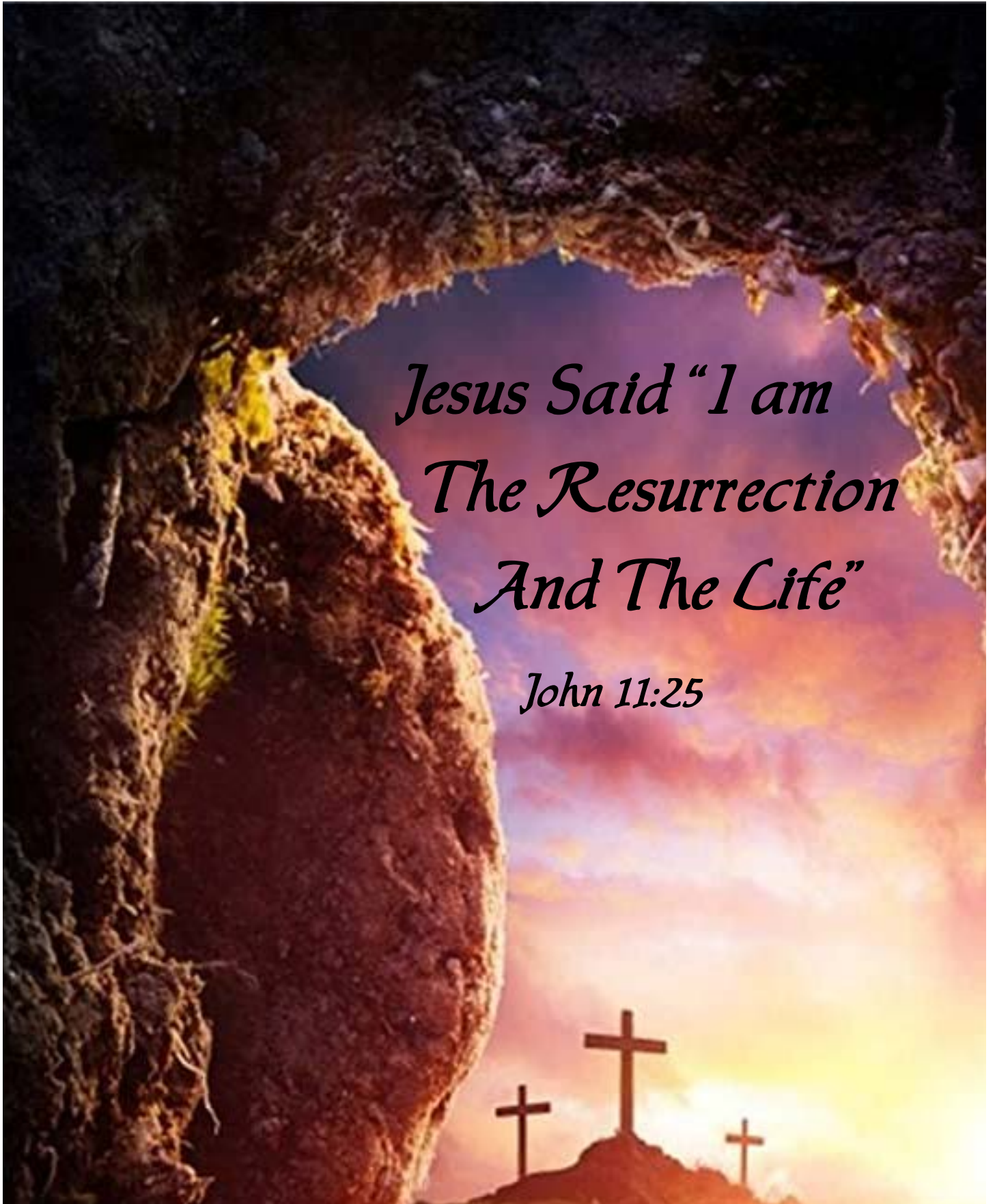

Spring has arrived and as with every year my wife and I watch as the flood waters of the Ottawa river creep up the river banks and spread across our property. This year is no different with the water already one metre above normal levels and still rising. And this is just the first part of the flood consisting of our local snow melt. In a few more weeks the melting snow in the northern regions will start to accumulate and add to our already swollen river. In 2019 we evacuated due to high flood levels, watching our neighbours and community devastated by the water. We stood in shock as buildings filled with water and some even being swept down river, the devastation was unimaginable. Our house was fortunately safe though other buildings on our property were flooded with over 20 cm. of water. Every year we wait and pray the waters will not rise too high, anxiously we watch reports and worry will this year be better. Knowing, we must leave it in Gods hands.

There are many things in life we can control with our advancing technology. This sometimes makes us feel as if we are the ones in the driver's seat controlling our destiny. Is mankind so arrogant to think that with a snap of our fingers mother nature will bow down to our requests. The reality in life is we can exert control over our own lives by the decisions we make, and we must accept the

consequences of our decisions. As well we must realize how our choices will affect others around us. This can manifest itself within family, friends, community and in our cases our brothers and sisters in our lodges. Mankind does not always consider the consequences of our actions.

The stories they told me of what is happening at home are far worse for the common people than our new medias tell us. Of course, some stories are too disturbing and graphic to publish.

These people were affected by the decisions of another country, they had no control to say stop do not involve us. Though they did make a choice to make Canada their choice of refuge. I asked the obvious question what do they think of Canada, and other than that Winnipeg very cold and windy, they loved our country and the friendliness of Canadians (Friendly Manitoba). Many long to return home and some are seriously wishing to stay and be-

come citizens of our country. Their reasoning is we live in a great country where we have unlimited choices on how to live our lives. To them Canada represents the freedom they dreamed for their own country after they became a democracy. I seriously wished them all the best in the future and we even exchange contact information, as I pray, they can fulfill their dreams of a future.

So, Brothers and Sisters as Newton's third law of motion states for every action there is an equal and opposite reaction, so do our actions have the same result. We cannot always foresee the consequences in our actions though we must accept what we do. At each level of our association, we must weigh our decisions including Most Worshipful. We can only try to do our best.

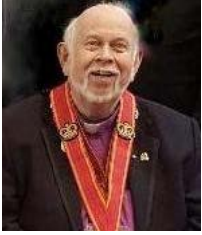
I wish all our jurisdictions all the best in their provincial sessions, and my congratulations to all out going and incoming executives, may you make choices that bear good fruit in the future.

Grand Chaplains Message of Faith

The millennial Kingdom is the title given to the 1000-year reign of Jesus Christ on the earth. Some seek to interpret the 1000 years in an allegorical manner. They understand the 1000 years as merely a figurative way of saying “a long period of time”, not a literal, physical reign of Jesus Christ on earth. However, six times in Revelation 20: 2-7, the millennial kingdom is specifically said to be 1000 years in length. If God wished to communicate “a long period of time”, He could have easily done so without explicitly and repeatedly mentioning an exact time frame.

Revelation 20: 2-7 “and He laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him one thousand years, and cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled and after that he must be loosed a little season.” The Bible tells us that when Christ returns to earth, He will establish Himself as king in Jerusalem, sitting on the throne of David.

Luke 1:32-33 “He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the highest and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of His father David. And He shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever and of His Kingdom there shall be no end. The unconditional covenants demand a literal, physical return of Christ to establish the kingdom. The Abrahamic Covenant promised Israel a land, a

posterity and ruler, and a spiritual blessing.

Genesis 12: 1-3 “Now the Lord had said unto Abram, get thee out of your country and from your kindred, and from your father’s house, unto a land that I will show you, and I will make you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great and you shall be a blessing. And I will bless them who bless you and curse him who curses you and in you shall all families of the earth be blessed.” The Palestinian Covenant promised Israel a restoration to the land and occupation of the land.

Deuteronomy 30: 1-10 “and it shall come to pass, when all these things are come upon you, the blessing and the curse, which I have set before you, and you shall call them to mind among all the nations, where the Lord your God has driven you, and shall return unto the Lord your God, and shall obey His voice according to all that I command you this day, you and your children, with all your heart, and with all your soul. That then the Lord your God will turn your captivity, and have compassion upon you, and return and gather you from all the nations, whither the Lord your God has scattered you.

If any of yours be driven out unto the outmost parts of Heaven, from thence will the Lord your God gather you, and from thence will He fetch you. And the Lord your God will bring you into the land which your fathers possessed, and you shall possess it, and He will do you good, and He will do you good, and multiply you above your fathers.

And the Lord your God will circumcise your heart, and the heart of your seed, to love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul,

that you may live. And the Lord your God will put all these curses upon your enemies, and on them who hate you, which persecuted you. And you shall return and obey the voice of the Lord and do all His commandments which I command you this day. And the Lord your God will make you plenteous in every work of your hand, in the fruit of your body, and in the fruit of your cattle, and in the fruit of your land, for good, for the Lord will again rejoice over you for good, as He rejoiced over your fathers.

If you shall hearken unto the voice of the Lord your God, to keep His Commandments and His Statutes which are written in this book of the law, and if you turn unto the Lord your God with all heart and with all your soul.” The Davidic Covenant promised Israel a king from David’s line who would rule forever—giving the nation rest from all their enemies.

2 Samuel 7:10 -13. “Moreover, I will appoint a place for My people Israel, and will plant them, that they may dwell in a place of their own, and move no more neither shall the children of wickedness afflict them anymore, as beforetime. PROFILIC WRITER



Brother Milton McTaggart, who is an honorary member of Frasersville LOL 46 Ontario East and is 94-years young, has and is giving new meaning to the idea that you are “never to old to re-invent yourself”. Brother McTaggart, who decided to start his writing career at age 86, has composed more than 25 books (all non-fiction) having sold more than 4,000 copies of his writing.

His books have been read by people from Newfoundland to British Columbia and from Sudbury to Florida, and one copy was picked up by a member of Canadas armed forces and shared with forces members in Afghanistan.

Brother Taggart joined LOL 392 in Hastings May 6th. 1945 at the age of 17 when there were 21 Lodges in the County, and was elected as County Master of Center Hastings in 1962

His first book was written at the request of The Heritage Centre in Tweed who asked him to write about his memories of the area. His knowledge of local history in Hastings County, the Municipality of Tweed and it’s surrounding Hamlets for over the last 250 years enabled him to write volumes of interest.

During Canada’s 150th. Anniver-

sary celebrations he sent a copy of this to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and received a letter of thanks from Buckingham Palace which he is seen holding in the picture..

Brother McTaggart, who retired in 1992 at 65 continued to work part time for 10 years, after which he devoted his time to taking care of his wife, 10 years later she sadly passed away. It was following this that he started writing. His second book recounted his Fathers experiences during the Great War of 1914 – 1918 following which his writing was fully developed as more than just a pastime.

One of Brother McTaggart’s books speak to his life. One of them is “Little things that make big Memories” 12 short stories, some of which were published in Reader’s Digest and the possibility that there will be more in the future.

Bro. McTaggart who writes by hand (no computer) then on a typewriter, completes the job by printing the work and adding a cover. These sell between \$10 - \$20 and when asked why not put on a hard cover he responded by saying, “it would not make the content any better and would be adding more cost”.

Milton attributes his longevity to hard work, early rising, positive outlook on life, never smoked or drank alcohol, can be found at his table in the Belleville Market every Saturday and on Sunday he is at the Value Mart in Tweed.

In closing, when asked the question does he ever gets stressed, his simple response is..**WHY ?**

PROV. GOL NEWFOUNDLAND SUPPORTS DAFFODIL PLACE

In 1963 to commemorate, the 100th anniversary of the arrival of the Loyal Orange Association in Newfoundland in the spring of 1863, it was decided by the Grand Orange Lodge of Newfoundland to open the Loyal Orange Association Hostel, which was located on Forest Road in St. John's in the vicinity of the General Hospital. The purpose was to be a home-away-from-home for lodge members and their families who were dealing with cancer. The Loyal Orange Lodge Hostel Corporation was incorporated on Sept.3, 1964.

Eventually, the Hostel closed and the property was sold. The funds from the sale were placed in trust until the concept of a new Cancer Hostel began to circulate. In 2007, it was decided by the GOL-NL to make a donation on behalf of our members of \$250,000.00 in support of Daffodil Place. The GOL-NL was the first to make a donation.

To date there has been \$7,000,000.00 raised for the construction of this very worthwhile endeavor. Daffodil Place opened its door in 2009 becoming a home-away-from-home for all cancer patients and their families. And during 2022, 324 guests stayed a total of 6913 nights at a cost of \$50.00 per night for 2 people charged by the Cancer Society while the actual cost is \$120.00 per night with the difference being made up by donations.

The GOL-NL continues to support Daffodil Place with annual donations with the help of funds collected from our lodges around our great province and plan to continue to support Daffodil Place into the future. As of 2022, the GOL-NL has donated in excess \$300,000.00 to this very important and worthwhile cause.

With it's new slate of officers the county recently elevated a father and son from Ivy 450 into the Blue Degree.
